To: Parents of six Somali executed

H.E. The Saudi Ambassador,

We are writing following the request from the parents of the six Somalis executed in Saudi Arabia on Monday, April 4, 2005.

It is their view that justice has not been served neither the Islamic religion (deen) nor the fundamental Human Rights have been taken into account with regard of their case. Furthermore, the judged criteria under International Law with regards of foreign nationals was not considered.

It is the express wish of the parents that we investigate the case and be satisfied that the correct procedures were adopted before a judgment to execute the six Somalis was delivered.

In order to form the right opinion and to compile a report, we request copies of files concerning each of the deceased stating:

- The offences committed – i.e. specific details of the charges brought against each one of them.
- The circumstances of the offences.
- The evidence against each one of them.
- Witness statements.
- The contact details of the team that represented them legally or otherwise.

We also kindly ask for details of any Somalis currently in custody in Saudi Arabia.
